**PROGRAM OF EVENT FOR THE CULPEPER MINUTE MEN CHAPTER
SCHEDULE JULY 3, 2010**

10:30 am - Muster at Culpeper Courthouse to set up speakers stand and canopy and table for signing of facsimile copy of Declaration of Independence.

11:45 am - Culpeper Minute Men Color Guard and firing team assemble at location indicated by Color Guard Commander Lon Lacey. Blue Ridge Chorale will perform Revolutionary War Songs prior to the Posting of Colors.

12:00 pm - Colors will be posted by Culpeper Minute Men Color Guard.
Gar Schulin, President, Culpeper Minute Men Chapter will preside and introduce guest speakers.
Lon Lacey will give brief history of the events leading up to development of the Declaration of Independence. Jim Bayne will read the Declaration of Independence.
The Blue Ridge Chorale and the SAR will lead children and adults in the singing of Revolutionary War songs.
The CMM firing team (muskets and rifles) will fire a volley salute following the last song.
All those in attendance will be given the privilege of signing the Declaration of Independence following the close of the program.
The Color Guard will then retire the colors.

3:30 pm - Parade participants will assemble on Piedmont Street one block east of Main.

4:00 pm - Parade will begin and proceed to Main St. south past the Culpeper Museum to the CMM Battalion obelisk.
