Larry McClanahan, a former President General of the Sons of the American Revolution, (and dual member in CMM) gave a historical program on religious liberty to the French Lick Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) at the recent May meeting. Mr. McClanahan, dressed in colonial garb, portrayed his ancestor Rev. William McClanahan of Culpeper County, Virginia. Mr. McClanahan related that religious liberty did not exist in all the 13 colonies prior to the Revolutionary War. He displayed a copy of a colonial arrest warrant for Nathaniel Sanders and Rev. William McClanahan for “preaching and teaching contrary to the laws of His Majesty and stirring up unrest and sedition among His Majesty’s liege people.”
