And distinguished guest speaker, Mr. Michael G. Macdonald gave memorable presentation pertaining to items from the American Revolutionary War era. Antiquities presented included the mourning silk sewn by the family of General Joseph Warren, killed at the Battle of Bunker Hill; and rare First Edition books by Thomas Jefferson, "Notes on the State of Virginia," and John Marshall's "Life of George Washington." A fine portrait of Benjamin Franklin and a very rare set of miniature portraits depicting King George III and his family members were also shared. Our members were equally fascinated to hear a few firsthand accounts of some of the history he participated in.
