

**Fun History Questions:**

1) By 1779, how many Americans were fighting with the British and how many were fighting with General Washington? British had about 8,500 Americans fighting with them. Washington had approximately 3,500.

2) A Revolutionary War soldier was supposed to get how much rations every day?

A Revolutionary War soldier was supposed to receive each day, one pound of fresh beef, one pound of salt fish, 12 ounces of pork or 20 ounces of salt beef. He also received one pound of bread, flour, one pint of milk, one quart of cider or spruce beer. Three pounds of candles and eight pounds of hard soap were allotted weekly for each 100 men. Each man's ration of Indian meal was one pint, plus three pints of "pease" and six ounces of butter.
