

Funds, Dues, etc.

(1) The Fiscal year shall begin on the first of January. Notice of dues due shall be sent by the Treasurer to each member in ~~November~~ October of each year. Annual dues shall be payable by the first day of ~~January~~ December in each year.

If a member is in arrears in payment of his annual dues on the last day of ~~March~~, December, he shall be dropped from the rolls of membership. A member

The Treasurer shall collect all fees and dues and shall have custody of all funds of the Chapter.
